# AKKODiS Launches the Innovation Nation Japan Program to Reclaim Japan's Lost Three Decades

### Behind the creation of the Innovation Nation Japan Program

Japan is seen as a country leading the world in social issues due to the accumulation of various issues, such as a declining birthrate and aging population as well as a shrinking labor force. In order to resolve these issues and be reborn as a "leading problem-solving country," it is not enough for individual companies and organizations within companies to engage in limited activities alone. Instead, co-creation between diverse industries and businesses as well as collaboration between educational and research institutes are necessary. This program was created to produce innovation through co-creation that transcends company and industry borders in order to work toward resolving the issues that Japan faces.



### Main activities of the program

<u>Phase 1 (scheduled for June – September): What did Japan lose during the "lost three decades?"</u> <u>The program's founding members will discuss how to create a bright future for Japan by sorting</u> <u>through the fundamental issues and selecting which issues to tackle.</u>

- Highly experienced consultants from AKKODiS will participate as founding members and share their thoughts.
- Ideas will be put together through candid and open exchanges of opinion and discussions with the founding members of the program.

### <u>Phase 2 (scheduled for October onward): An action task force to resolve issues will be established</u> and new members who excel at taking action will be invited.

- A project will be established for each issue with a team to discuss plans to put solutions into action.
- After formulating solutions, new members from a diverse range of specialist fields who excel at taking action will be invited to put plans into action.
- The solutions will become assets for restoring Japan, and when other countries in the world face the same social issues, Japan will be able to lead solutions as a precedent.
